- No claim for damaged parts or issues with a product finish will be accepted after the product has been installed.

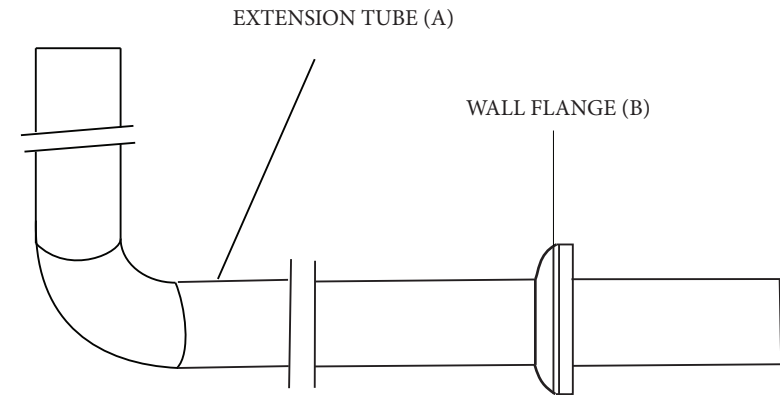
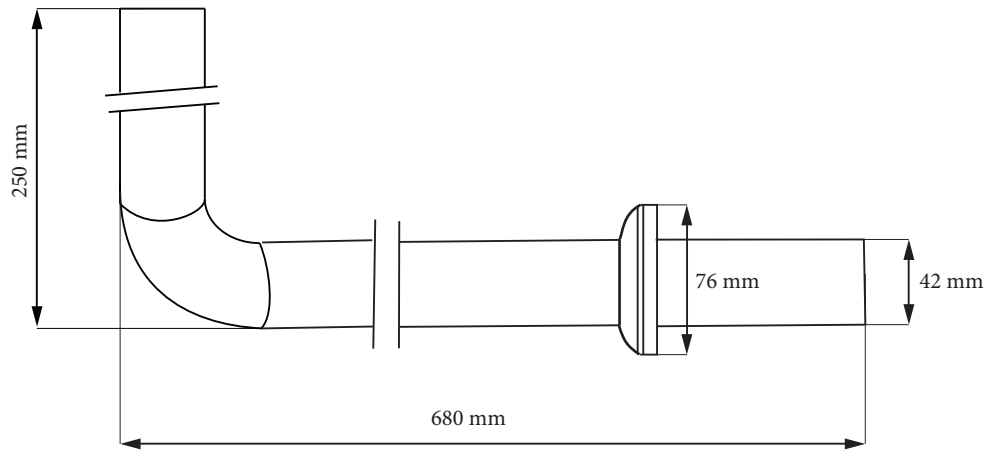
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INSTALLATION



Fitting Instructions

1. Identify and assemble parts as shown
2. If necessary extension tube (A) can be cut to length to assist with fitting
3. Push the long side of the tube fully into the trap and mark the floor at the point where it will exit to go under the floor. The hole in the floor will need to be approximately 45mm diameter.
4. Secure the extension tube (A) into the trap using the outlet nut and conical washer supplied with the trap.
5. Slide the wall flange (B) over the tube so that it will cover the hole in the floor.
6. The extension tube can be connected to the plastic waste outlet pipe by using a 1 1/2" multi-fit plastic connector.

GENERAL INSTALLATION TIPS

- Handle parts carefully and consider wearing gloves for living and brushed finishes.
- Only use water or soapy water to clean visible parts.
- Where silicone is required, only use neutral cure silicone.
- Chemicals should be kept away from this product. Splashes and sometimes vapours from household cleaning fluids, marble sealers and grout haze removers can cause damage.
